

Watco Scholarship Application

In 2016, Watco developed a scholarship for dependents of Watco team members in an effort to enrich the lives of our team and their families.

Applicants for the Watco Scholarship must be a graduating senior who is a dependent of a Watco team member. The recipient must be in good academic standing and plans to attend a post-secondary institution within one year following high school graduation. The number of scholarships awarded will be determined by number of applicants with a minimum of two \$500 scholarships being awarded. The scholarship will be issued in two \$250 disbursements for the first two semesters of college and will be credited to the recipients account at the financial aid office of the college of their choosing.

Applicants should submit the following application with the most recent copy of your high school transcript and two letters of reference from either a teacher, coach, employer, or community leader who is not related to the applicant. Applications should be turned in no later than March 31st, 2022.




