In 2016, Watco developed a scholarship for dependents of Watco team members in an effort to enrich the lives of our team and their families.

Applicants for the Watco Scholarship must be a graduating senior who is a dependent of a Watco team member. An applicant must be in good academic standing and must plan to attend a post-secondary institution within one year following high school graduation.

The number of scholarships awarded will be determined by number of applicants with a minimum of two \$2,000 scholarships being awarded. The scholarship will be issued in two \$1,000 disbursements for the first two semesters of college and will be credited to the recipient's accounts at the financial aid office of the college of their choosing.
